BS31100, a new British Standard for risk management was launched in October 2008. It is designed to provide guidance to a range of organisations seeking to improve their risk management practices and processes.

About BS31100

The British Standard 31100 – Code of Practice for Risk Management was launched in October 2008. Its objectives are to provide guidance on risk management best practice to companies of all sizes and from all industries. BS31100 is the basis for the proposed international risk management standard, ISO 31000, due out on 30 June 09.

BS31100 is designed to provide a basis for understanding, developing, implementing and maintaining risk management within any organisation in order to enhance an organisation's ability to achieve its objectives. This British Standard establishes the principles and terminology for risk management and gives recommendations for the model, framework, process and implementation of risk management.

BS31100 Self-Assessment

Manigent's BS31100 Assessment survey is designed to provide organisations that have adopted or are working toward adoption of BS31100 with a simple, web-based self assessment tool which provides an overview of organisational maturity with respect to BS31100 and risk management more generally.

The questions within the assessment incorporate the key aspects of BS31100 and can be completed by an individual or team. The results will be presented in a dashboard format using 4 levels of maturity- Initial, Competent, Proficient and Expert. Additionally, comparison dashboards will provide benchmarking by industry, company size and risk management experience.

BS31100 360° Assessment

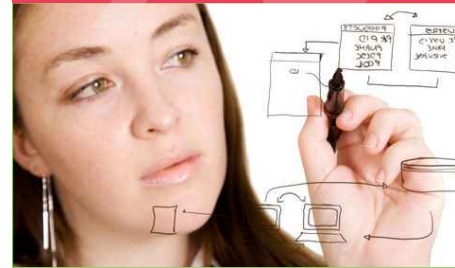
The BS31100 360° Assessment is a tailored assessment and improvement package for organisations wishing to implement BS31100. It builds on both the Self-Assessment and Action-based Assessment however it takes a more organisation specific approach.

The BS31100 360° Assessment package involves a pre-assessment workshop to understand the assessment objectives, identify the right functions and people to be involved and plan the post assessment follow-up. During the assessment individuals from a number of levels and functions within the organisation will be asked to complete the online self-assessment. Once all the assessments were completed Manigent will analyse the results and conduct a series of post-assessment improvement workshops. During the workshops your organisation's results will be presented and compared across the various different functions and levels. The results will also be compared to peer organisations.

The aim of these workshops is to develop a shared view of the organisation's approach to risk management, to engage the organisation in a BS31100 driven improvement programme and to develop an actionable programme of work to enhance risk management and achieve BS31100 compliance.
