The MI Audit seeks to identify opportunities, firstly, to reduce the costs related to management information and secondly, to realise greater value from it.

The initial focus of the MI Audit is typically on cost reduction by rationalising the software tools in use. Thus capturing savings via reducing maintenance charges, ongoing training costs and development/support headcount. This stage of the MI Audit is designed to deliver real, immediate cost reduction and bottom line benefits.

With a roadmap to a less complex environment, attention can be turned to realising greater value by identifying 'gaps' in the existing MI outputs. These may be in the context of your business strategy or risks. Once these gaps have been identified, a cost-benefit analysis is completed to prioritise work to close the gaps. With this stage of the MI Audit the benefits are realised over time through better decision-making and action-taking.

The Process

The MI Audit process is designed to be a short, focused process (1-2 weeks) with very clear and well defined outcomes. With an initial focus on reducing MI costs, Manigent uses a proven cost driver model to quickly identify and quantify key costs within your



MI environment. A cost-benefit analysis is completed to determine the realisable benefits of undertaking a MI rationalisation project, typically leading to the identification of significant potential cost saving opportunities through reductions in maintenance charges, ongoing training costs and development/support headcount. At this stage, a client may choose to undertake any project(s) required to realise this value, with or without Manigent's support.

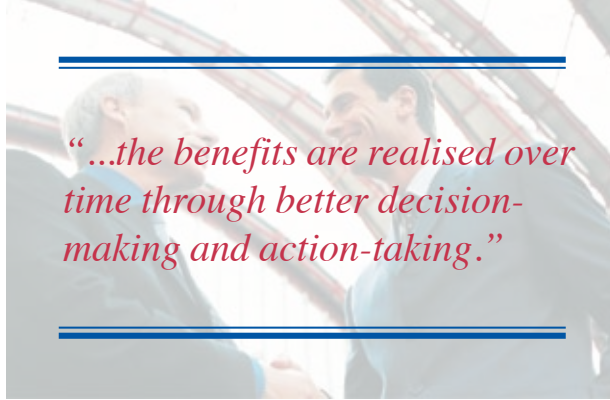
